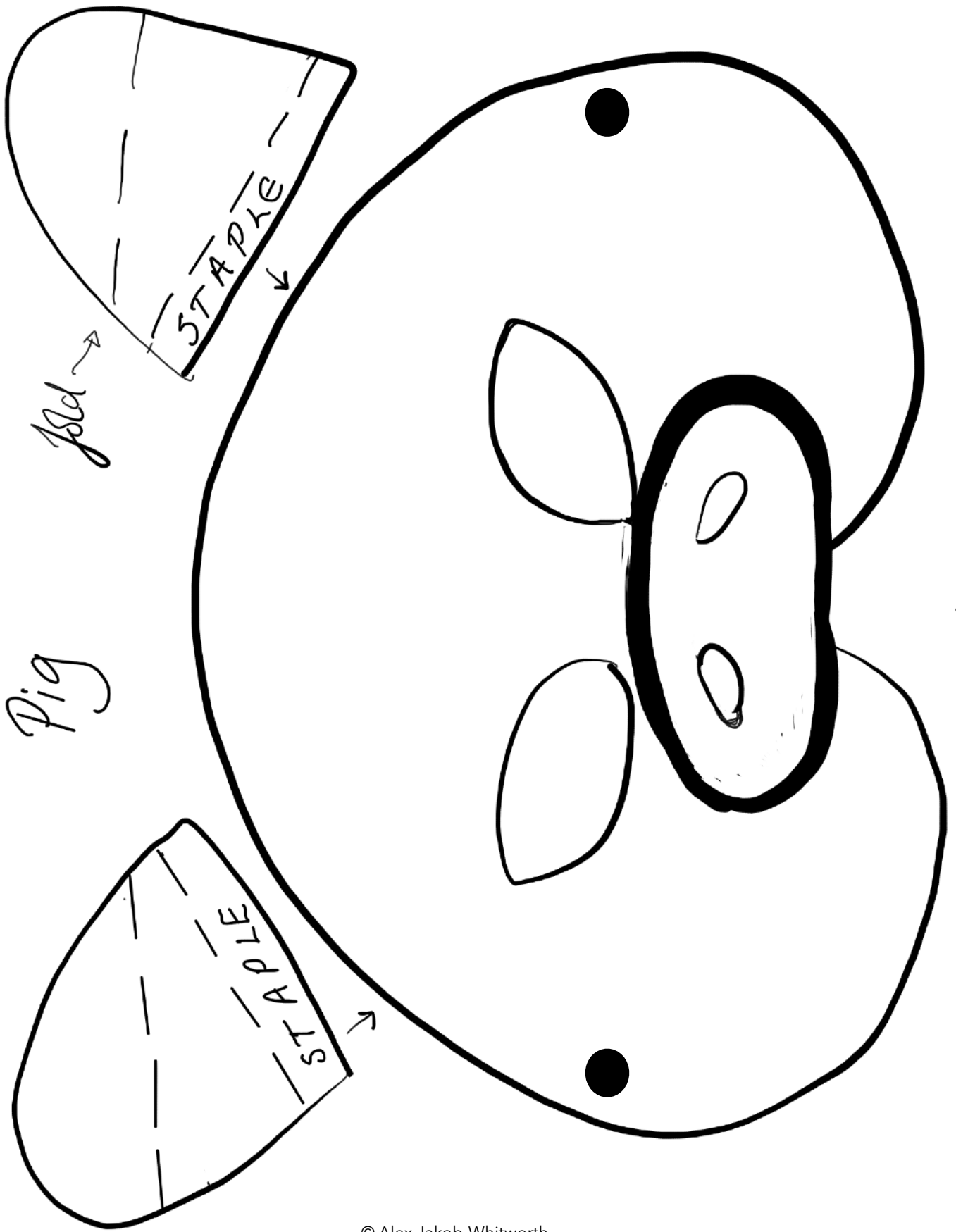




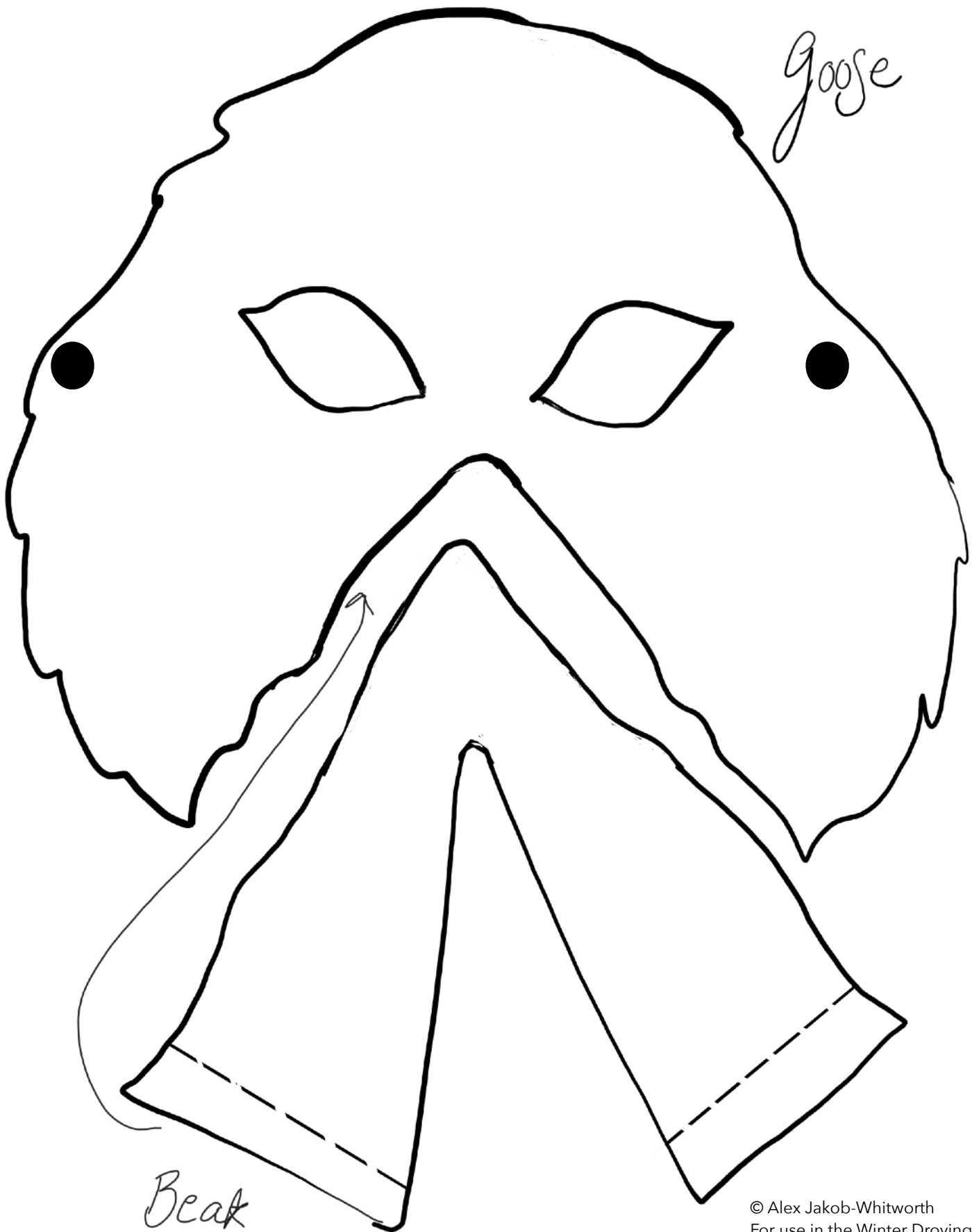
Making the Winter Droving Masks

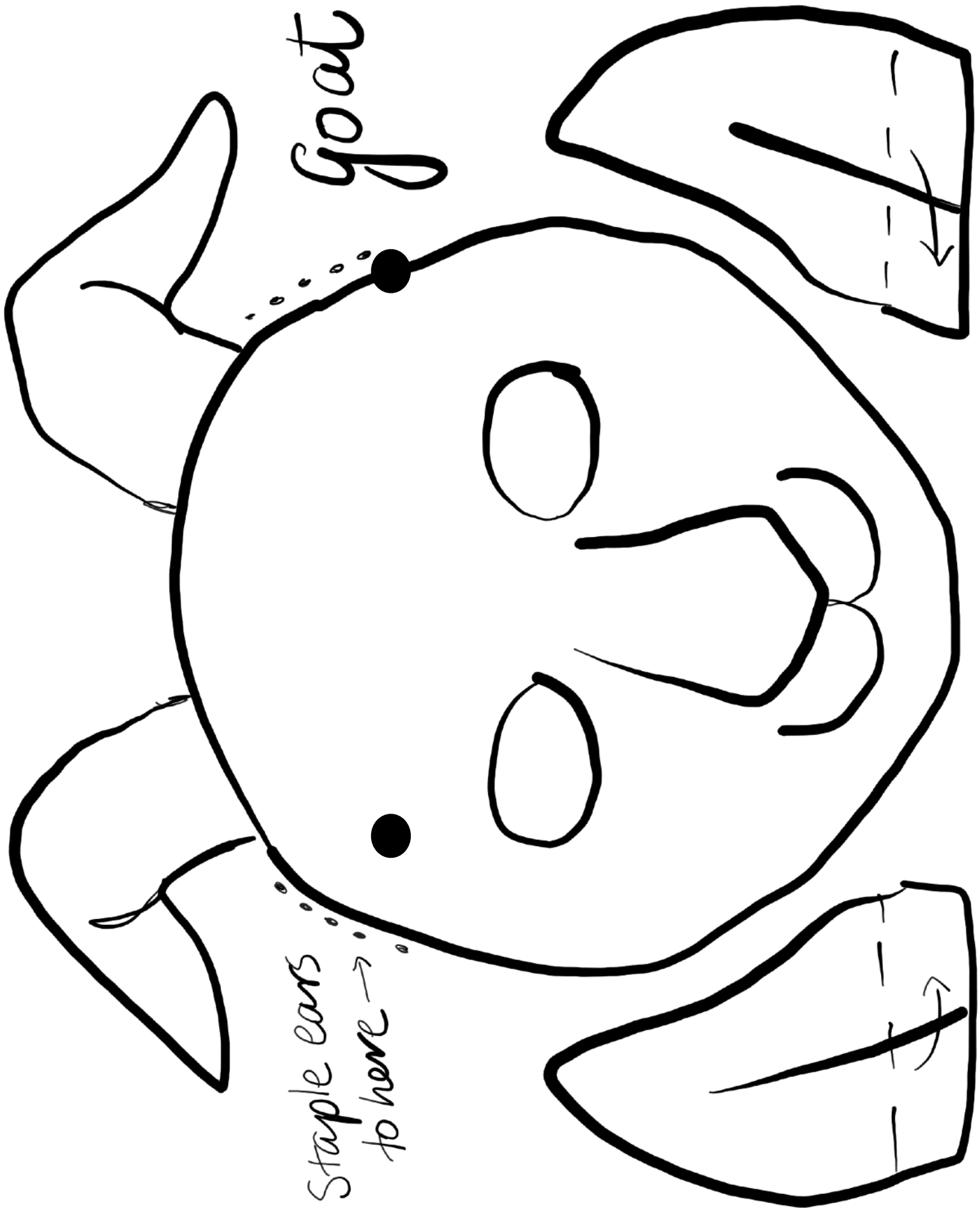
- Print out
- Glue onto card (not too much glue, but make sure it is evenly spread)
- Cut out the pieces, then do your finer cut to the shapes.
- Decorate your mask how you want - you can use "realistic" colours, or you can be as imaginative and as creative as you like!
- Some ears need the bottom sections, cutting (along the solid line), then sliding in front of each other, then stapling to the mask. This makes them a little more three dimensional.
- Embellish your mask with manes, or beards or nose-rings as you wish!
- Don't forget to cut the eyeholes!
- Use tape, ribbon, or elastic (best) to hold the mask over your head. Attach this to the holes on the diagrams - *check first* - as every head is different, to see if the holes are in the best place for you.
- Drove on...

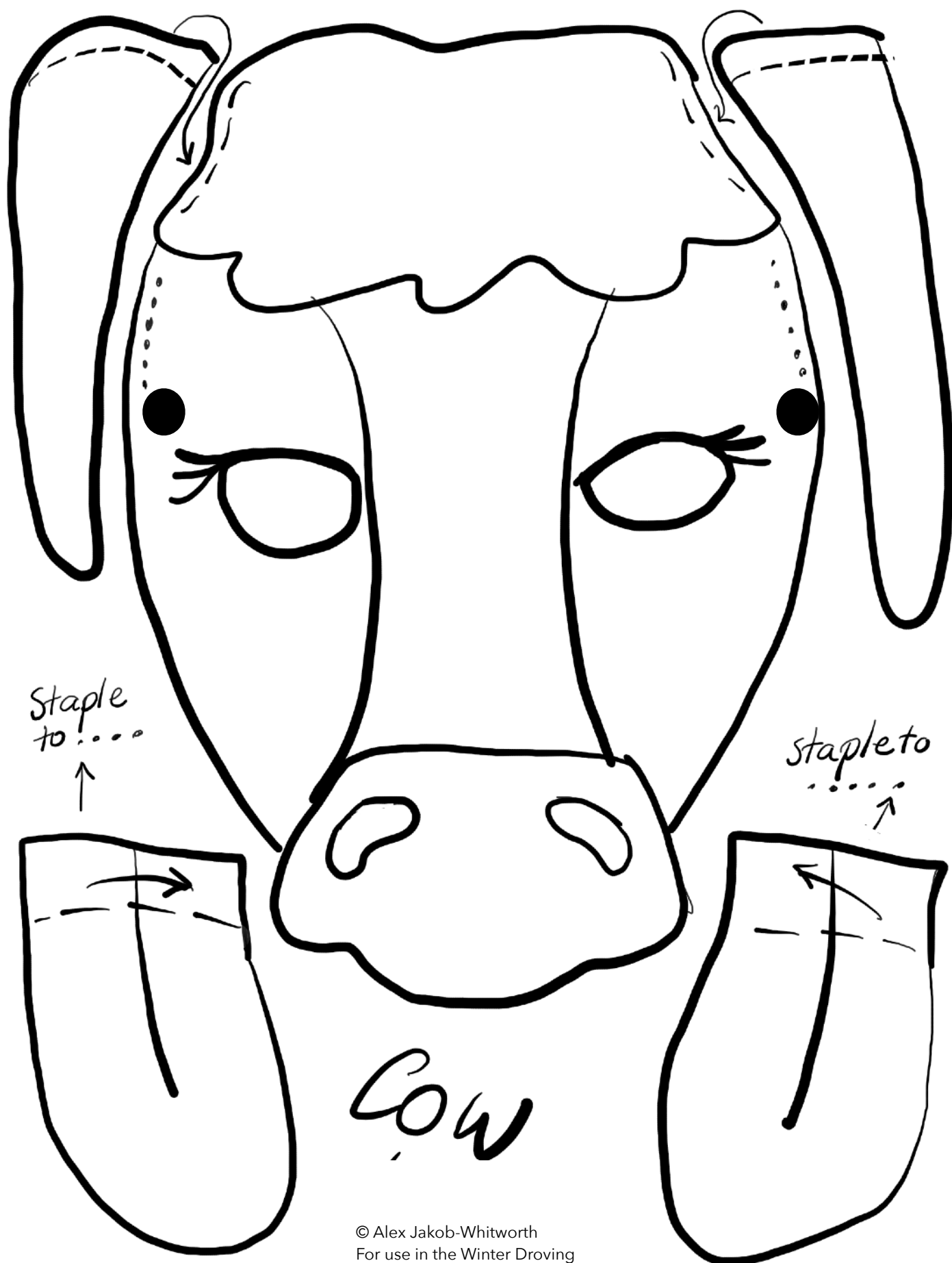
